Vogue schedules news conference to announce partnership with It's On Us

What: [Anna Wintour](#), editor-in-chief of [Vogue](#), will announce the magazine's partnership with national sexual violence prevention organization [It's On Us](#) at 9 a.m., Friday, March 29 in [One World Trade Center](#). Wintour will reveal the first collaboration between Vogue and It's On Us which will be a groundbreaking fashion exhibition.

Who: Wintour and Tracey Vitchers, executive director of It's On Us, will make statements. Both will take questions. Copies of their statements will be available for members of the media.
